Since 2006 the Water Leaders Program has evolved to include advanced development tools to train water professionals to become more effective in charting a path toward innovative and collaborative solutions. While the program covers examples of water-related leadership challenges and case studies, the primary focus is individual growth. Participants receive extensive training in skills related to navigating conflict and diversity, leading self and others, and effective problem-solving. Graduates leave with better understanding of their strengths and how to utilize them, learn how to address challenges in their workplace and the broader community, gain skills to enhance their team or projects, and form a network of peers to further their career growth.

ADMISSION: Admission is competitive with applicants selected based on their experience, geographic and professional diversity, and potential for future leadership positions.

TUITION: Program cost is \$4,000 per person which includes training sessions, individual assessments, personalized coaching, and program coordination and materials.

**SCHOLARSHIPS:** A limited number of partial scholarships are available. Scholarships are highly competitive and based on both need and merit. Complete the scholarship portion of the application to be considered.
