PROGRAM INFORMATION:

Format: Four program days with highly sought-out lectures, discussions, exclusive access to water sector leaders, breakout networking opportunities, a complete set of WEco's Citizen's Guides, reading assignments, and applied learning. Class size is limited to 35 people.

Approximate time commitment: 35 hours over 4 months.

Topics covered: Colorado water legal and institutional frameworks, water resource planning and protection, and Colorado's water for the future.
