WHAT IS THE WATER FLUENCY PROGRAM?

A professional development course geared toward anyone interested in gaining an in-depth understanding of Colorado water management and protection. Participants develop context for navigating water management and policy issues and leave equipped with relevant knowledge and a network of peers to create lasting, positive change in their community.

WHO ATTENDS?

Elected officials, city/county staff, community and business leaders, special districts staff, board members for water organizations, educators, and water sector professionals new to Colorado or looking for broader exposure to issues. Class size is capped at 35 to maximize interaction among class members and presenters.
